

GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

Articles will be reviewed prior to being accepted for publication. Manuscripts should be submitted as a Word document, pages numbered, double spaced with wide margins. The author should retain another copy as BAHNON takes no responsibility for returning materials.

A proof for correction will be sent to you before publication.

The front page should contain the author's name, professional qualifications, present position, address, daytime telephone number and / or email. If there is more than one author all should be named but full contact details need be supplied for one person only.

Abbreviations can be used as long as they are defined at first mention.

References -Harvard style please.

Illustrations -If they are not the author's own, we will need permission /copyright.

Author's are responsible for obtaining consent from their employer or patient if required particularly when publishing items such as case studies, audit reports. Assistance with materials or funding must be acknowledged

Articles should normally be between 500 and 2,500 words, although this can be exceeded when agreed with the editor. Headings are always helpful.
